Rensselaer County School Music Association Solo Scholarship Festival Thursday, May 8, 2025 *The Robert C. Parker School*

The 2025 RCSMA Solo Scholarship Festival will occur on Thursday, May 8, 2025, at the Robert C. Parker School. Interested students should read the following information and submit a student application and the application fee (to your teacher) no later than Thursday, March 28th. Once all applications are received, a schedule of audition times and further information will be given to teachers to distribute.

Objectives:

- To develop music excellence as a solo performer.
- To encourage the performance of solo literature.
- To **foster** the continued study of music.
- To recognize outstanding performing musicians of Rensselaer County.
- <u>College Scholarship Requirements</u>: Performance of a solo comparable to a Grade V or VI listed in the NYSSMA Manual. In multi-movement works, the performer should perform **two (2)** contrasting movements.

Time limit: 10 minutes.

The applicant must be a graduating senior continuing his/her education in music (i.e., music ed./ music industry/ musical theater/ music therapy, etc.). Music must be his/her **major** in the course of undergraduate studies.

College scholarship auditions <u>must</u> be performed with an accompanist, unless the selection is intended to be performed unaccompanied.

First place - \$1000 (payable upon receipt of proof of college registration). Second place - \$500 (payable upon receipt of proof of college registration).

- <u>Music Camp/Private Study/Instrument Purchase Scholarships:</u> Performance of a solo comparable to a NYSSMA listing grade III or higher. Performers are encouraged to use an accompanist; however, it is not required at this level. Time limit: 5 minutes
 - grades 11-12
 - grades 9-10
 - grades 6-8

Each category has two awards of \$300 and \$150.

- 3. All applicants must be a member in good standing of his/her RCSMA school music department.
- 4. Evaluation of the soloist will be by three non-Rensselaer County Adjudicators representing instrumental, strings, & voice.

- 5. A \$10 application fee is required (Checks made out to RCSMA).
- 6. Each contestant is allowed only one performance.
- 7. *Photocopied music is prohibited*. A second original copy of the solo(s) must be provided for the adjudicators.
- 8. Students must submit applications and registration fees to their school's music teacher.

For teachers only:

Online Applications must be submitted online by April 4 by the RCSMA teacher. (*Student forms are due on March 28th to give teachers time to meet this deadline*) The \$10 per student application fee must be <u>postmarked by March 31st</u> and sent to:
